Opening times and costs

The TreeHouse will open for October half term - Thursday 21 October to Friday 29 October inclusive - from 7.50am to 4pm.

9am to 4pm core hours cost £32.50 per child per day plus supplements where applicable. Early Bird drop off is 7.50am and costs an additional £4.25 per child per day. Prices include snacks and hot lunch (or picnic lunch on Out & About days).

Cancellations and absence

If you have to cancel at short notice (less than 1 week) we will try to fill the place. If we can fill the space you will not be charged but if not, payment in full is required.

In the event of missed days due to sickness we are not able to offer a refund.

COVID restrictions?

Sunflowers at Grafton are maintaining many of the protective measures we have had in place over recent months to minimise risk of COVID-19 infection.

We are limiting the number of families attending holiday club each week in order to keep the number of contacts experienced by your children and our team to a minimum. We have a minimum booking of 2 days for the October holiday club.
